1. Introduction of Mrs. Colleen Smith

- SCC members introduced themselves to Colleen Smith, the new school principal for next school year.
- Mrs. Colleen Smith introduced herself to the SCC. Colleen Smith comes from Parkside Elementary, where she has been principal for six years. Previous to that she was the Murray District Curriculum Teacher Specialist, and she taught sixth grade at Grant Elementary for five years.

2. Review and approve Land Trust Plan for 2017-2018

- SCC reviewed the proposal: reading intervention & math intervention goals as discussed in previous meeting.
- SCC unanimously approved the Land Trust Plan and signed the approval page. Craig Woolston approved via phone and will come to sign approval in the morning.

3. Review and approve CSIP

- **SMART performance Goal:** By Spring of 2018, 80% of students in Kindergarten will be on benchmark as shown by scores on PSF; 80% of students in grades 1-2 will be on benchmark as shown by scores on DORF fluency, and 10% more students in grades 3-5 will score on the advanced or proficient levels on the Spring 2018 SRI assessment than on the Fall 2017 SRI assessment; and 50% of non-proficient students in 3rd, 4th and 5th grade will improve their scores by at least 100 Lexile points on the SRI between Fall 2017 and Spring 2018 assessments.
- **School Climate Goal:** increase percentage of teachers with a ratio of positives to correctives of 4 to 1 in all classrooms to 85% by Spring 2018 as measured by informal walk-throughs, informal observations, and formal observations.
- Tess Hortin suggested removing the attendance improvement detail since attendance is more parent-driven than impacted by educators.
- Both CSIP goals were unanimously approved.

4. Other Items

- Summer 2017: the district is replacing all cabinets and installing new playground.
- Summer 2018: the carpets (including walls) will be replaced.
